Preface

The “**CWDS Library Resources Series**” is an attempt to highlight the various aspect of our specialized library collection relating to women and development studies. The materials available in the library are in the forms of books and monographs, reports, reprints, conferences papers/proceedings, journals/newsletters and newspaper clippings.

The present bibliography “Women of North East India” presents material on diverse aspects of women’s status and other related issues in the North East India its eight states of Assam, Arunachal Pradesh, Manipur, Meghalaya, Mizoram, Nagaland, Tripura and Sikkim.. The bibliography contains the references available in the CWDS Library both in published as well as unpublished forms in a variety of formats.

The bibliography covers references from 1980 to 2012 and contains 400 entries. It is divided into two parts.
